It is hereby declared that copper has not been used in:

1. Tap water pipes >1% weight of copper.
2. Roof and facade cladding materials and products for roofs and facades (roof drainage products, gutters, exhaust hoods, eaves nets, cover profiles and the like) with more than 10% by weight of copper.

Some exemptions may apply based on the product type and situation. All relevant exemptions, if any, are stated below. Closed pipe systems such as heating or cooling circuits are not covered by the requirement.

Exemptions:

- A. Visible pipelines in bathrooms.
- B. Water fittings connecting pipes, such as couplings or manifolds.
- C. Installation cabinets, such as manifold or water meter cabinets.
- D. Pipelines that due to national fire protection legislation must be made of copper and where alternatives are not available.
- E. Pipes through the wall for an outdoor tap.
